#### NEW YEAR GREETINGS TO ALL!

As building work on the annex at the Playhouse Theatre that will house our Wurlitzer pipe organ has already commenced, we are sure hoping that this year is going to be the start of a new beginning for the Trust, our Wurlitzer pipe organ and you, our loyal Friends of the Wurlitzer.

We have three shows confirmed this year, the first will be presented in March on the Allen TH300 digital theatre organ and, fingers-crossed, the other two shows will be part of a "soft-opening" we have planned for the Wurlitzer in its new home at the Playhouse Theatre. The Official Premiere Show for the "Playhouse Wurlitzer" is planned for 02/02/2020!!

Once the organ is playable towards the middle of this year, a whole raft of work is needed to bed the pipes in and that mostly involves playing it! So, we may be having one or two FOTW afternoons where you can come along and hear some of our own number putting the organ through its paces while we iron out the bugs as they pop up. These will be interspersed with our two overseas artists from the USA in September and October. Our first show for 2019 is a real cracker! We are welcoming back a favourite entertainer for so many of you – Great Britain's Chris Powell. Although we had hoped the Wurlitzer would be ready, the show will still go on with grateful thanks to Roger Smith of MusicPlanet, who is providing the Allen TH300 for Chris' show.

**Chris Powell** has firmly established himself as one of the UK's premier 'entertainment organists' as well as a truly international ambassador in the field of electronic and theatre organ music. Born in Manchester in 1971, he emigrated to New Zealand with his parents when just 2 years old.

Returning to England at the age of 5, his education and formative while growing years up Lancashire saw him pursue his love of music with piano and organ studies culminating in a string of engagements for both local concerts and dances from the age of 14 onwards. By the time he was 18, he had successfully auditioned to join the team of organists playing for dancing at the Tower Ballroom Blackpool and began to be recognised for his musical talents leading to а succession invitations to perform at electronic and pipe organ venues.

Following his experience at Blackpool, Chris widened his talents to include work as a demonstrator




for several manufacturers including Farfisa, Orla and more recently Roland with whom he is now associated on a freelance basis and as such tours with their state-of-the-art AT-900C Atelier instrument.

1994 saw as invitation to return to New Zealand for a month-long concert tour on pipes and electronics which lead to an exciting invitation to spend all of 1996 as a Resident Organist at the 'Baycourt Theatre' in Tauranga. This was a unique and exciting experience; he undertook all manner of concerts, functions and dances while playing the Theatre's 10 rank Wurlitzer as well as accompanying the Operetta – 'The Merry Widow' on this much-loved vintage instrument to capacity crowds.

Since then, he has gone on to become one of the most popular performers in the UK and intersperses his regular annual diary of engagements in Britain with frequent overseas concert tours with have included Holland, Australia and the US as well as NZ in recent years. Chris was also interviewed and filmed in action for a documentary on cinema nostalgia which screened in NZ in 2002. 2019 sees his 16th tour of NZ and 9th of Australia.

- Because of the Performing Rights Act absolutely NO video or audio recording is permitted at our shows.


#### 2018 ATOS CONVENTION MEMORIES

Each year, the American Theatre Organ Society hold their annual convention, and last year *Friends of the Wurlitzer* member Mr Graham Upton was making a business trip to the USA and decided to combine it by joining in on this annual pilgrimage of theatre organ enthusiasts from all over the world.

Graham wrote in his return;

".....Well, needless to say, I had a fantastic time at the ATOS convention in sunny Pasadena! A great finish to my whirlwind American trip. The programme was very tight, and we barely had time to grab a meal between some events – travel distances are all so huge in the States but particularly in Los Angeles.







For me, the stars of the show were the British artists, particularly Richard Hills and David Gray who were incredible. David finished his concert with a full transcription of Tchaikovsky's 1812 Overture which really did sound like a full orchestra; this was on the El Capitan Wurlitzer (ex San Francisco Fox) which is probably the best maintained instrument in the USA by all accounts. The "Young Organist Competition" was also a highlight. Great to see 16-20 year olds that are so accomplished.

The second photo is the Reginald Foort 4/28 Moller touring organ now in Pasadena (played by R. Hills).

The last image is in a quirky little hall near LAX airport – the curtains open to reveal the pipework & traps all lit with coloured LED lights.

I returned home feeling very envious of the sheer number of theatre organs that are available in the USA – there must be hundreds. Looking forward to getting our own Wurlitzer back into service soon!!

Jelani Eddington and Mark Herman both send their regards to all, and I also had a great chat with John Atwell from Oz.
