While construction of the organ chambers is now well underway, inside the Playhouse Theatre, our Wurlitzer organ's beautiful mahogany console is already "at home" on its new lift and was welcomed by our audience at Chris Powell's March show!

However, we are in need of a sturdy fabric cover to protect the console while down in the pit. There are timber planks that we drop in place over the hole once the console is down, but the small gaps between each section could see both dust and possible liquid spills seeping through on to the console. This coming from other users of the theatre working on the stage, oblivious of the treasure that lays beneath them.
